



How to use FIND MY – iPhone

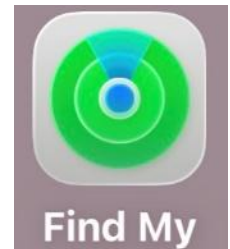
FindMy is Apple's built-in tracking service to locate missing **devices** like an iPhone, iPad, or Mac, personal **items** like an air tags or tablet, and even **friends** and family who share their location. It displays location on a map, lets you play a loud sound to find nearby devices, and helps protect your personal data if a device is stolen. FindMy tracks a lost item using the website @www.icloud.com/find

1. Turn on FINDMY –

Tap on FINDMY App – open the app

Tap Enable Notification – You can turn off or change later.

Turn on Location



2. Add Devices, People, or Items



Devices

Tap on the **Devices** Icon

Find all the Devices you can add to FindMy

Tap the Device to add to your FindMy list

People

Tap on the **People** Icon –

The People you can add must be a contact and Apple user

Remember - When you track them - they can track you.

Tap on Share My Location

Tap on the “ + ” to find a person or scroll to find the contact

Tap on person to request them to let you add them

Tap on the checkmark

Choose time duration – one hour, until end of day, indefinitely



After that person agrees to let you FIND them they show on the map
When a person adds you – You can accept or decline

Items

Tap on the **Item Icon**

The Items you can add are listed in your Items list

Tap to add to your FindMy list

Another way to find your device is to ask a FindMy friend to locate your device.

Remove or Erase a device if Lost/Stolen/Sold or Exchanging it.

Open FINDMY on a different device or computer @ www.icloud.com/find

Sign in to your account - Chose device Chose to Remove if you want to Exchange or Erase if Lost

To turn OFF FINDMY –

Go to Settings, Tap on your name, Tap on FindMy, Turn OFF
