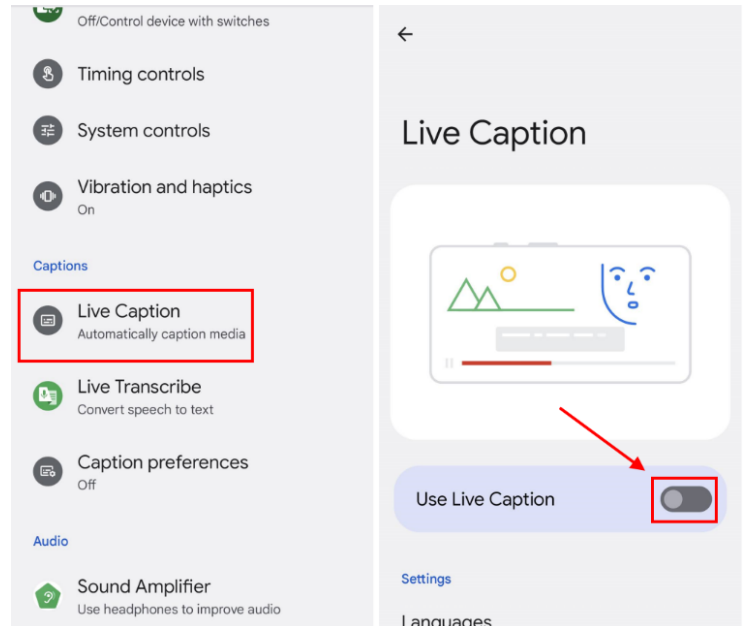


Turning on Live Caption – Android

Live Captions will automatically transcribe audio from a video or movie with words into real-time text on the phone screen.

Live Caption is available on every Android phone but it must be TURNED ON.

1. **Open Settings**
2. **Tap Sound & vibration**
3. **Tap Live Caption**
4. **Toggle Caption calls to ON/OFF**
5. **Now you can use Live Caption and turn it off.**



How to use Live Caption on an Android

Press the Volume Button:

1. Press the **Volume Up** or **Volume Down** button
2. A volume slider appears on screen
3. Tap the **Live Caption icon – looks like a keyboard, in a blue circle**
4. Or Tap the 3 lines on the volume slider
5. Then tap the keyboard with the blue circle. Live Caption activates immediately in any video that has audio





Turn on Live Caption on Calls – Must be turned on in settings.

1. Go to **Settings → Sound & vibration → Live Caption**
2. Toggle on **Caption calls**
3. During a phone call, Live Caption will transcribe both sides of the conversation on the screen.

Customizing Live Caption

Go to **Settings → Sound & vibration → Live Caption**

Options include:

1. **Caption profanity** — toggle to show or hide
2. **Caption sound labels** — shows labels like [Music] or [Applause]
3. **Caption call audio** — captions phone and video calls
4. **Hide captions when no speech** — clears the box when silent
5. **Language** — select your preferred caption language
