



Magnification – Android Devices

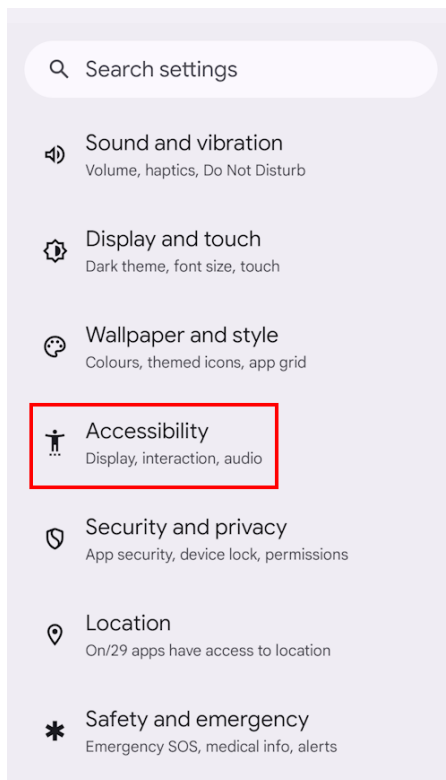
Menu names may look slightly different depending on the Android version or brand.

On many phones, the general path is Settings > Accessibility > Magnification.

On Samsung Galaxy, it may be Settings > Accessibility > Vision enhancements > Magnification.

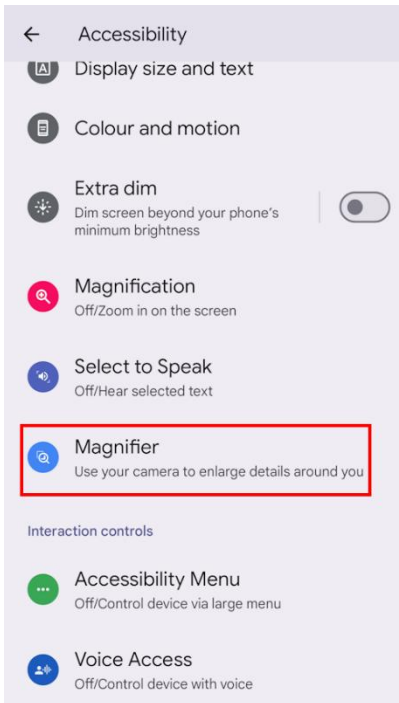
1. Open Settings

- Open the Settings app. Look for the gear icon, then tap Accessibility.



2. Choose Magnification

- In Accessibility, tap Magnification. On Samsung, look under Vision enhancements first.



3. Turn shortcut ON

- Tap the Magnification shortcut and turn it on. Choose the shortcut method your device offers.

4. Pick the View

- Tap Magnification type. Choose full screen, partial screen, or switch between both.

5. Use the Zoom

- Start magnification using your chosen shortcut. Pinch with 2 fingers to zoom in/out. Drag with 2 fingers to move around.

6. Turn shortcut OFF

- Go back to Magnification and turn the Magnification shortcut off when you no longer need it.
