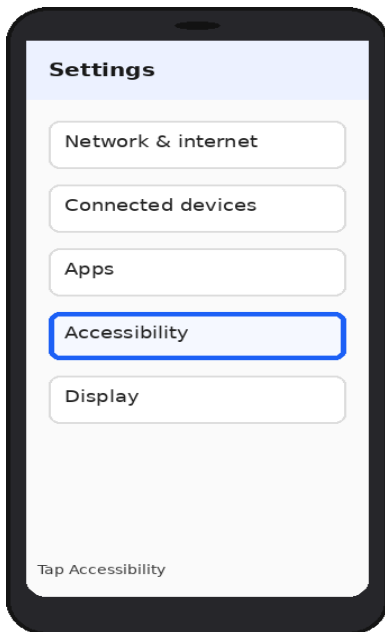


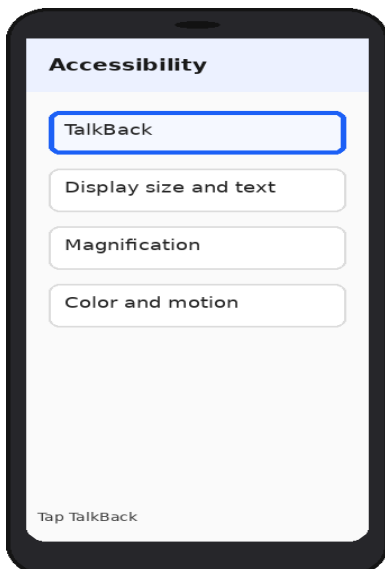
Talk Back - Android

TalkBack is the Android screen reader. It speaks what is on the screen and changes how tapping and scrolling work.

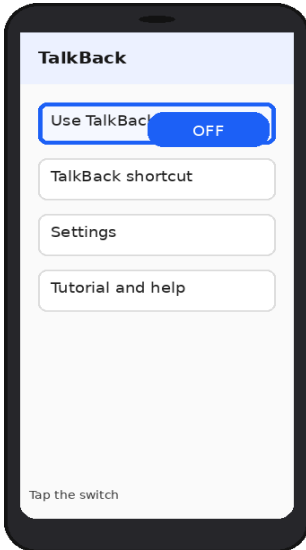
1. Open Settings and tap “Accessibility”



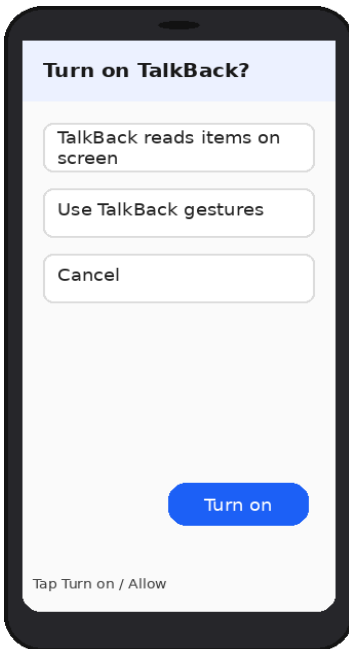
2. Open Accessibility and tap “TalkBack”



3. Open TalkBack and tap use TalkBack or the TalkBack switch.
 - a. On some devices it may be listed under Screen Reader



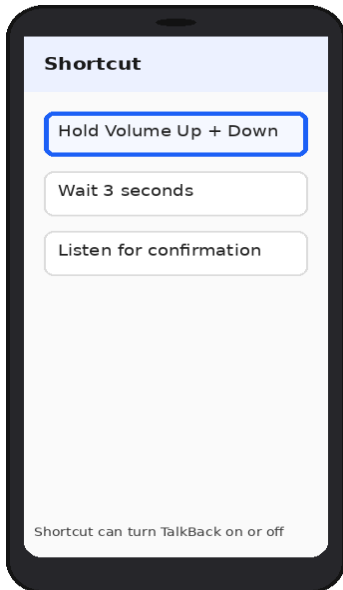
4. Turn TalkBack ON



To turn TalkBack OFF

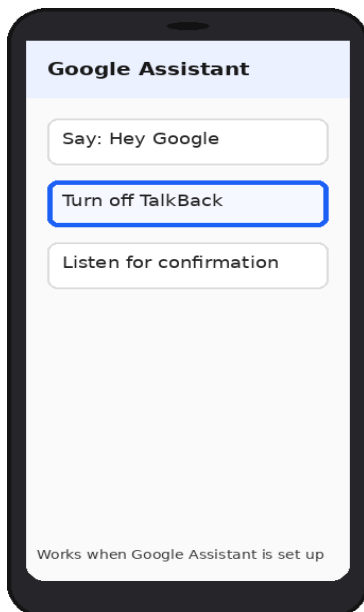
1. Volume Shortcut

- Press and hold both volume buttons for about 3 seconds. Listen for confirmation that TalkBack is off.



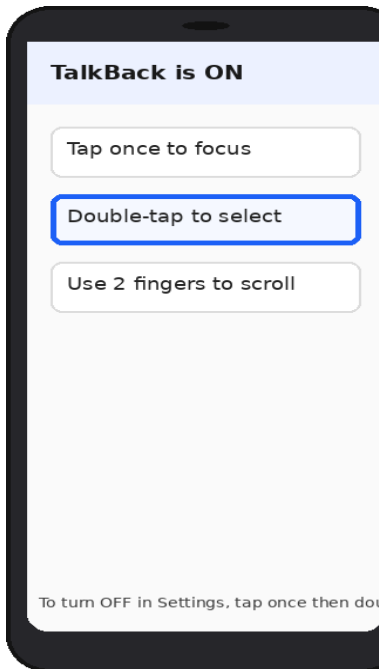
2. Google Assistant

- Say: "Hey Google, turn off TalkBack." This works if Google Assistant is set up.



3. Turn it OFF in Settings

- a. Go to Settings > Accessibility > TalkBack. With TalkBack on, tap once to focus and double-tap to select.



4. Prevent Accidental Activation

- a. After TalkBack is off: Settings > Accessibility > TalkBack > TalkBack shortcut. Switch it off if you do not want the shortcut.
