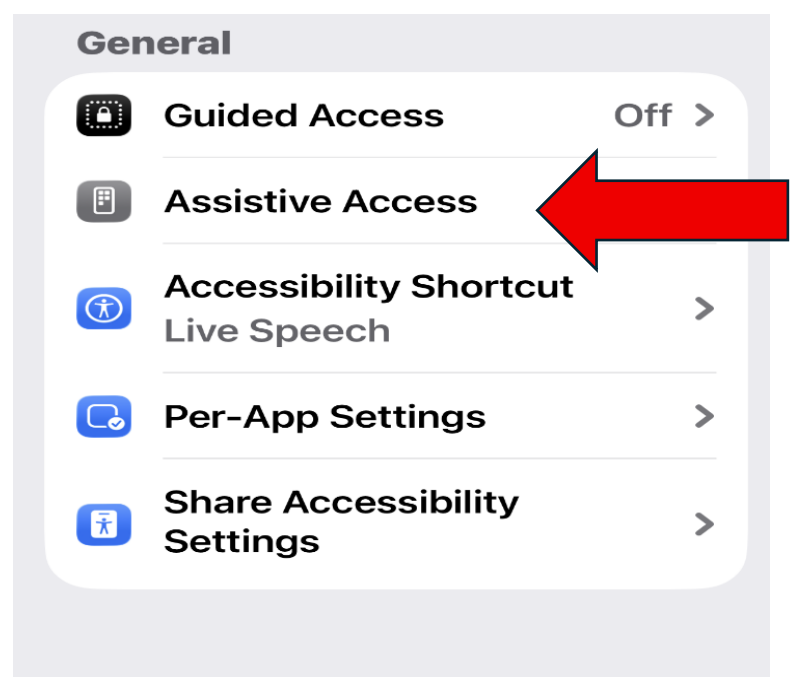
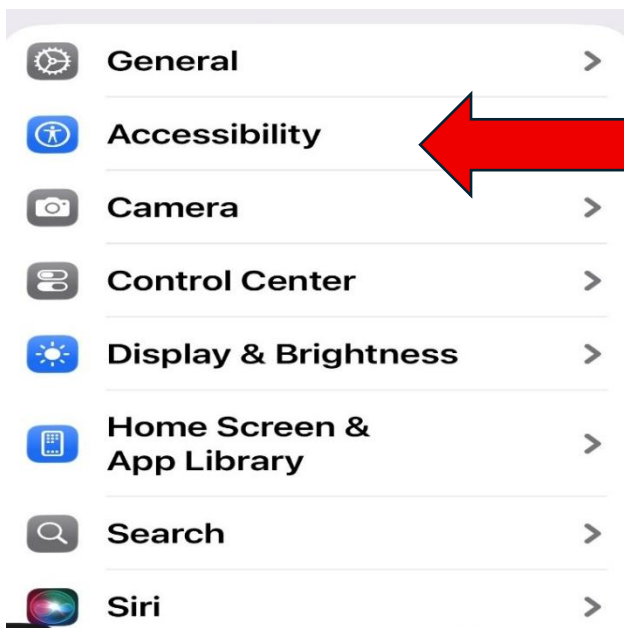


Assistive Access – iPhone

1. Open the **Settings** app on your device.

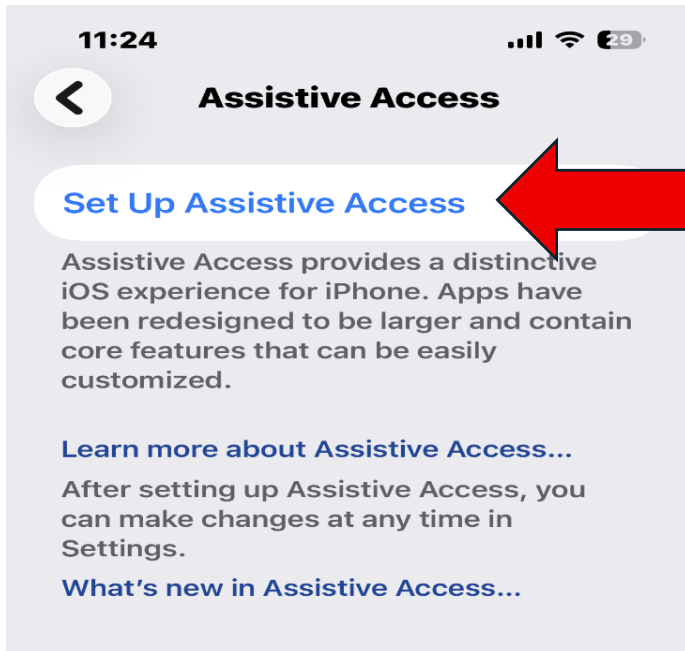


2. Tap **Accessibility** then **Assistive Access**



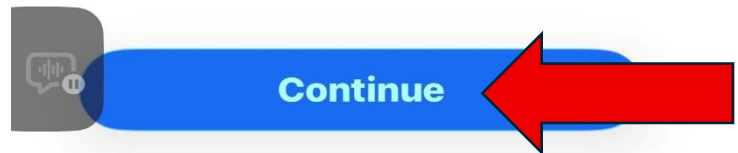


3. Tap **Set Up Assistive Access** then **Continue**

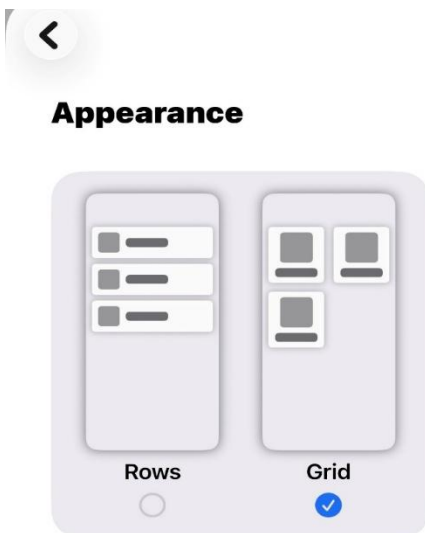

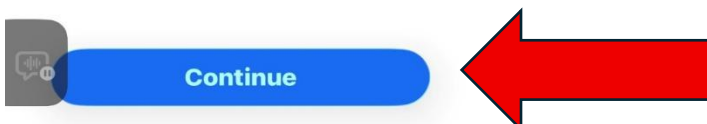
Select apps and customize options for the person who will be using Assistive Access on this iPhone.

Choose how icons and text will appear in Assistive Access. "Rows" will increase the size of text and display items in lists. "Grid" will make icons more prominent.



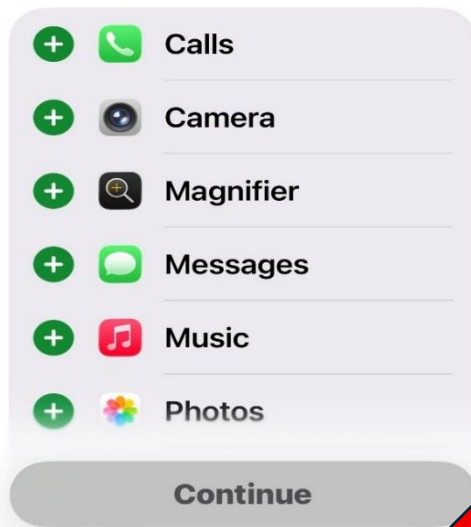


5. Tap the + to add apps to your home screen then **continue**

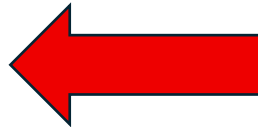
