Battery Saving Tips

1. Charge your phone before the battery gets very low.
2. Unplug the charger when the phone is fully charged.
3. Turn off the phone if you will not use it for a long time.
4. Keep the phone out of very cold places.
5. Keep the phone out of very hot places.
6. Do not leave the phone in a car on hot or cold days.
7. Turn off the screen when you are done using the phone.
8. Don't let the phone fall a long way.
9. Be careful around water with the phone.
10. Keep the phone charger and charging port clean.
11. Lower the screen brightness if it is too bright.
12. Use Battery Saver mode when the battery gets low.
13. Use the charger that came with the phone, or one approved by the manufacturer.
14. Turn off Bluetooth if you are not using it.
15. Turn off Wi-Fi when you are away from home and not using it.
