



How to Enable a Notification Light – iPhone

1. Tap **Settings** > **Accessibility**.

In older iOS versions, tap

Settings>General>Accessibility

2. Tap **Audio/Visual**.

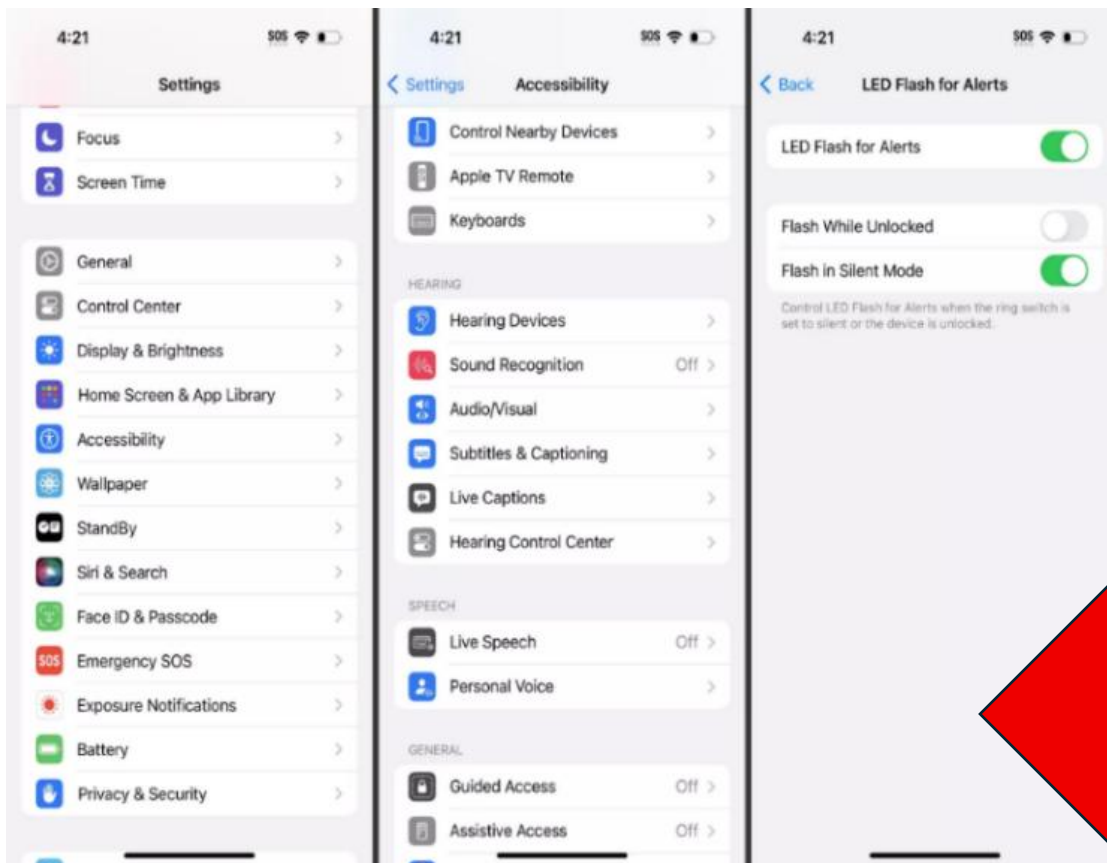
If you don't see this option skip this step

3. Select **LED Flash for Alerts** at the bottom.

If you don't see this option skip this step

4. Tap the **LED Flash for Alerts** toggle to turn it on. This enables the notification light for all alerts.

You can also turn on the **Flash in Silent Mode** toggle to keep the light enabled even when your phone is in silent mode.



How to Enable Haptic Alerts - iPhone

Turn On Vibration (General)

1. Open **Settings**
2. Tap **Sounds & Haptics**
3. Toggle on **Vibrate on Ring** and **Vibrate on Silent**

Adjust System Haptics

1. Go to **Settings** → **Sounds & Haptics**
2. Scroll down to **System Haptics**
3. Toggle on/off — controls vibration for keyboard taps, Face ID, Control Center, and other system interactions

Custom Vibration Patterns (Per Sound)

1. Go to **Settings** → **Sounds & Haptics**
2. Tap **Ringtone** (or **Text Tone**, **New Mail**, etc.)
3. Tap **Vibration** at the top
4. Choose a preset pattern (Heartbeat, Staccato, Rapid, etc.) or tap **Create New Vibration**
