

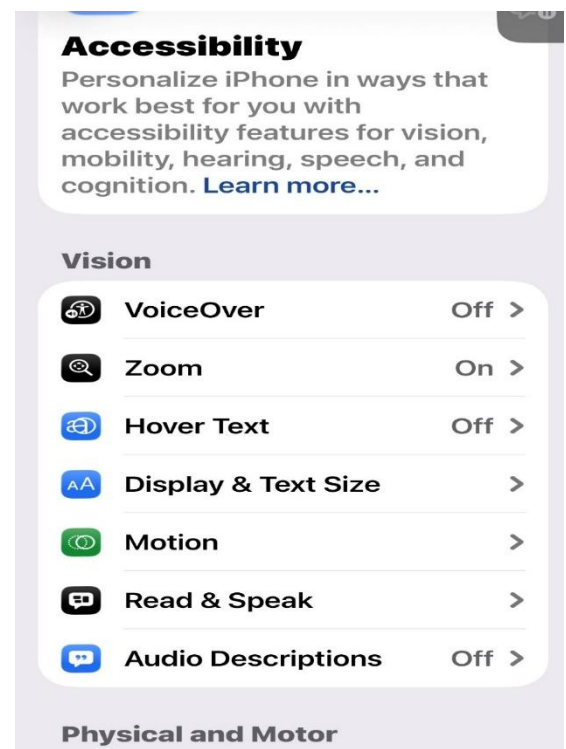
## General Mobile Accessibility – Tips & Quick Settings

1. Open the **Settings** app on your device and TAP **Accessibility**

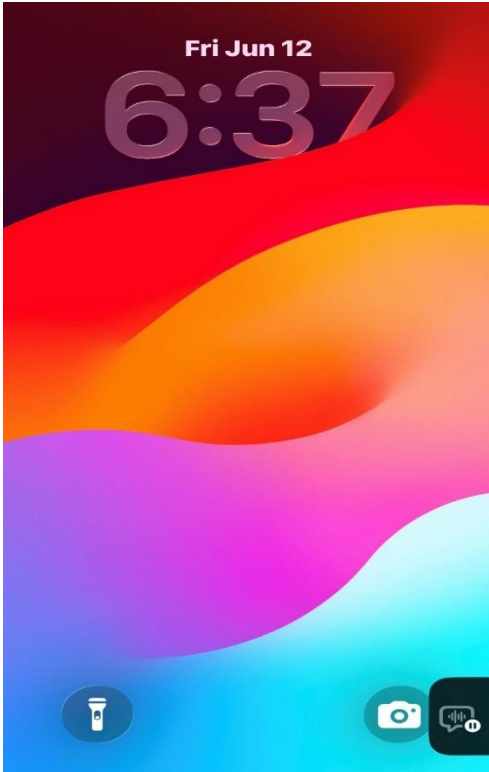


2. Listed are the accessibility features that are built in tools. They range from vision, motor assistance, hearing, speech, accessories, and general.

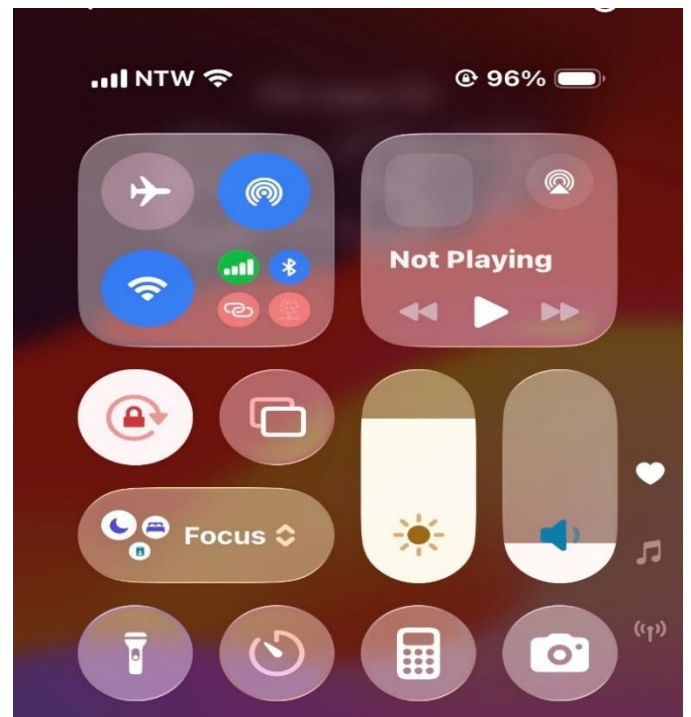


## iPhone Quick Settings

1. When you turn on your phone this is the lock screen. Swipe down from the top and it will open quick settings.



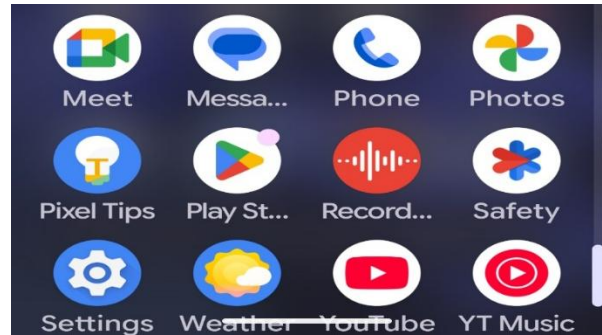
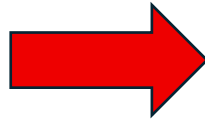
2. The screen controls essential features such as Wi-Fi, Bluetooth, screen brightness, flashlight, and many others for access.



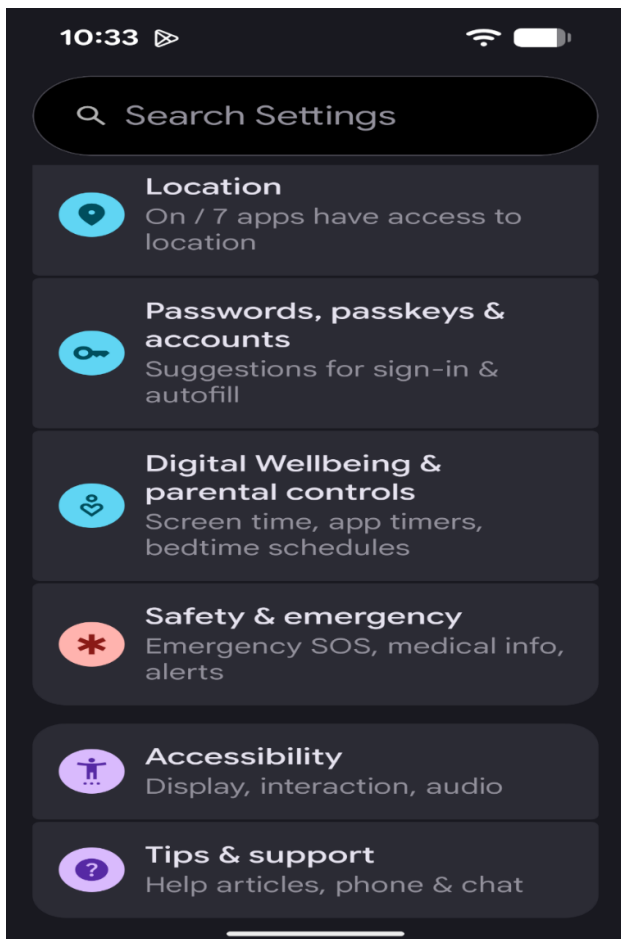


## Android Accessibility

1. Locate the settings icon on the home screen. It is a cog wheel shaped icon. Tap it.

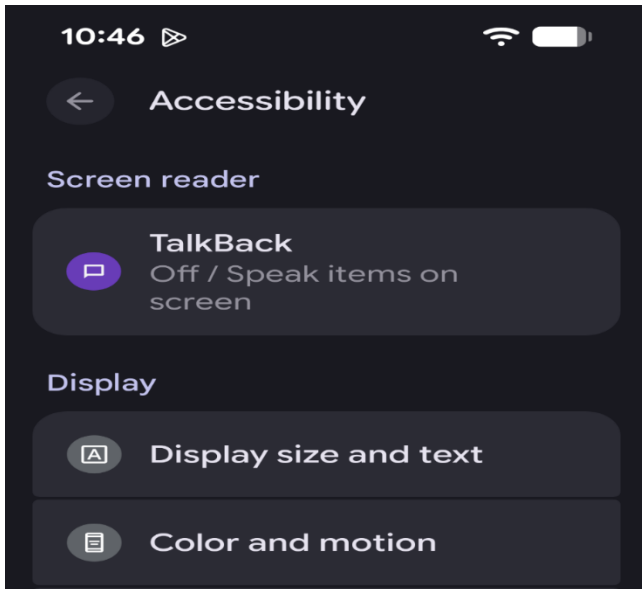


2. Scroll down and tap on the accessibility option.
