VoiceOver is Apple's built-in screen reader that speaks items on the screen and allows users to control their iPhone or iPad using gestures.

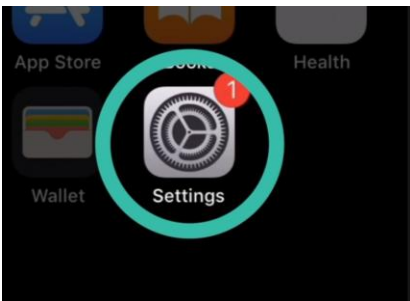
Turning Voice Over ON

- **Method 1: Using Siri**

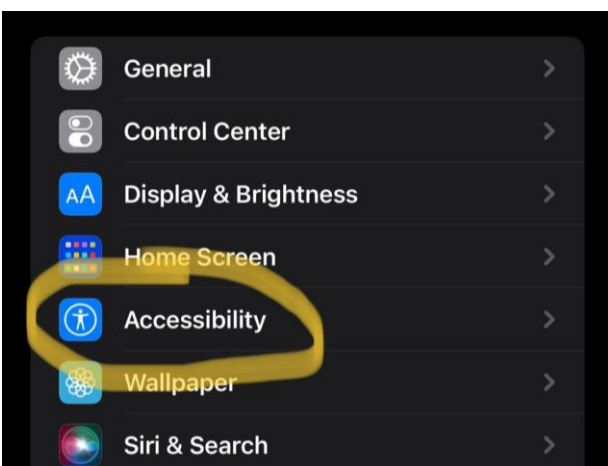
Say: "Hey Siri, turn on Voice Over."

- **Method 2: Through Settings**

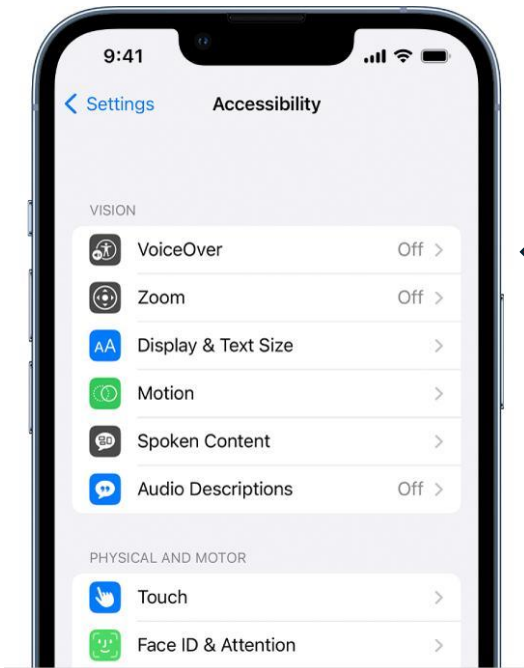
- Step 1: Open the Settings app. The icon can be found on "Home Screen."



- Step 2: Step 2: Select Accessibility

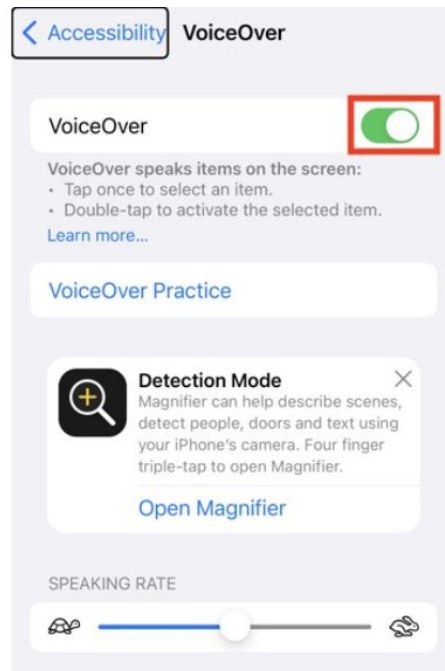
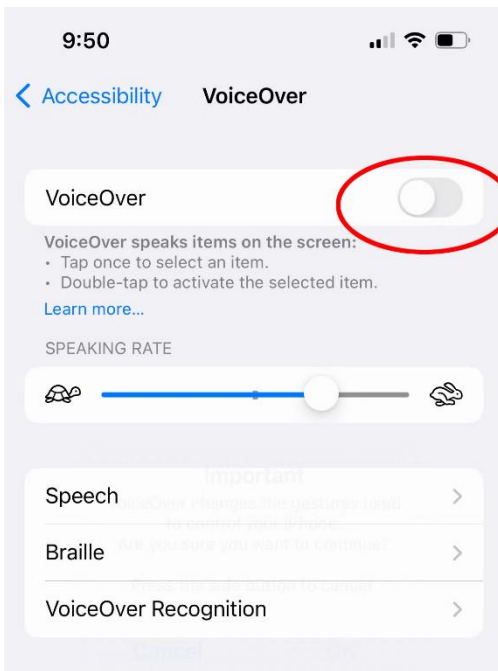


○ Step 3: Select Voice Over



○ Step 4: Turn Voice Over ON

- When the button is green, Voice Over is ON



- Step 5: Turn Voice Over OFF
 - Open Settings.
 - 2. Select Accessibility.
 - 3. Select VoiceOver.
 - 4. Turn the VoiceOver switch OFF.
 - When the button is gray, Voice Over is OFF
