

Lilly's Voice

Category: Communication (AAC) / Autism

Eligibility Criteria

Non-speaking or minimally-verbal children (roughly ages 2-18) who have been denied an AAC device by insurance/school or face long wait times, whose families have tried insurance/school/therapist routes first.

Application Process

Apply at lillysvoice.org; the organization holds an intro call to confirm fit, helps the family select the right AAC app, places the family in a queue, requires completion of an online parent-training program before ordering the device, then purchases and ships a full-size iPad with AppleCare and the chosen AAC app to the family's Apple ID, followed by a setup/training call.

Timeline / Deadlines

Rolling application, but placement depends on the family's position in Lilly's Voice's waiting list/queue; check the organization's Facebook page for current guidance on 'what to do before applying.'

Additional Notes

Small, volunteer-run nonprofit (no government or school/therapy-center affiliation) — encourages families to exhaust insurance/school options first.
